March Events



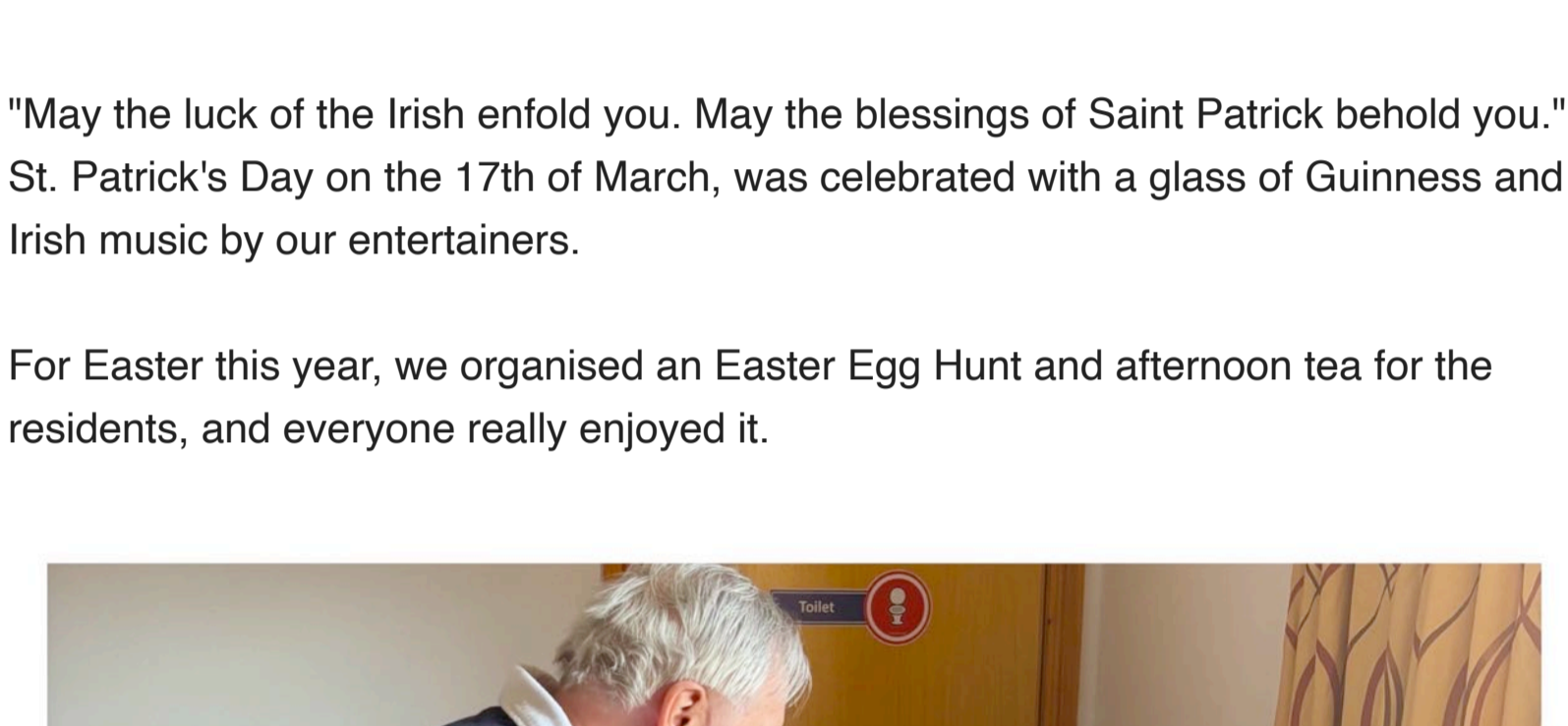
Afternoon Tea

Varied Activities

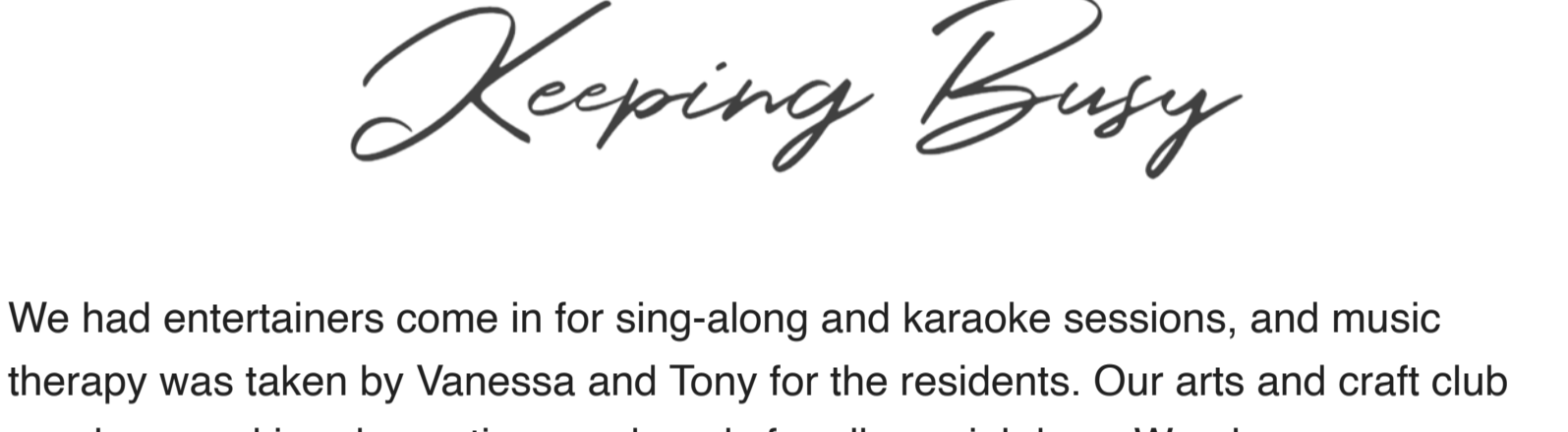


Keeping Busy

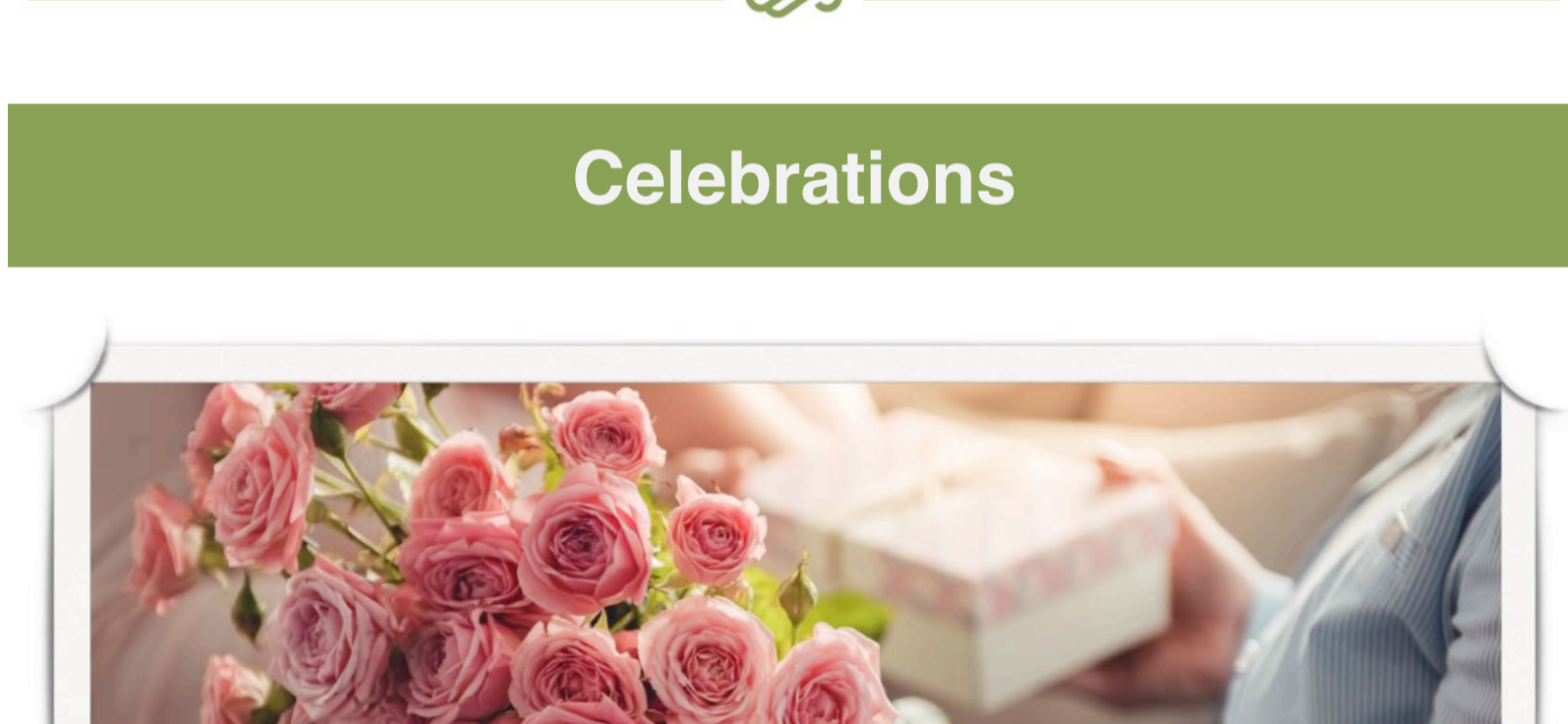

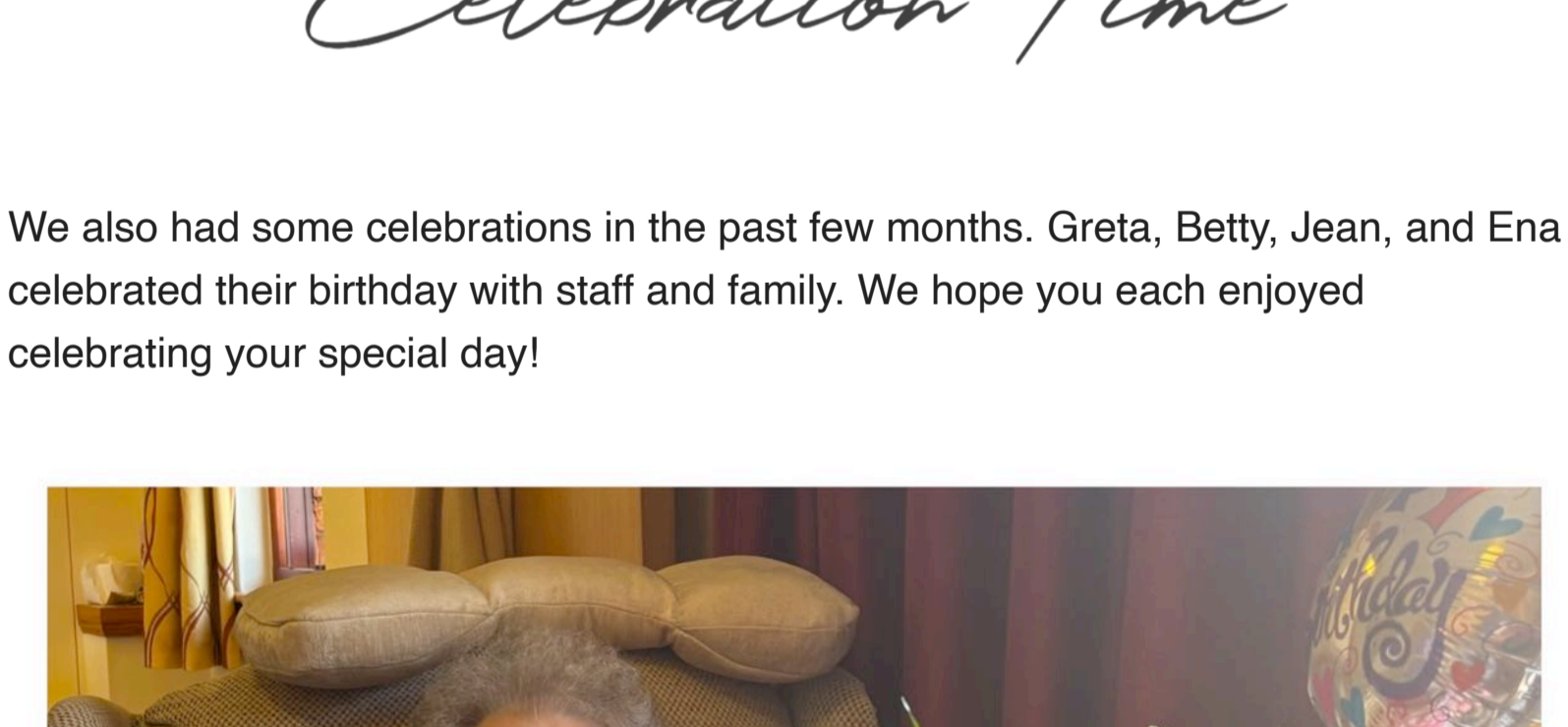


Celebration Time

Harry and Diana also celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary in Struan Lodge with their nearest and dearest, here is to many more happy years together!

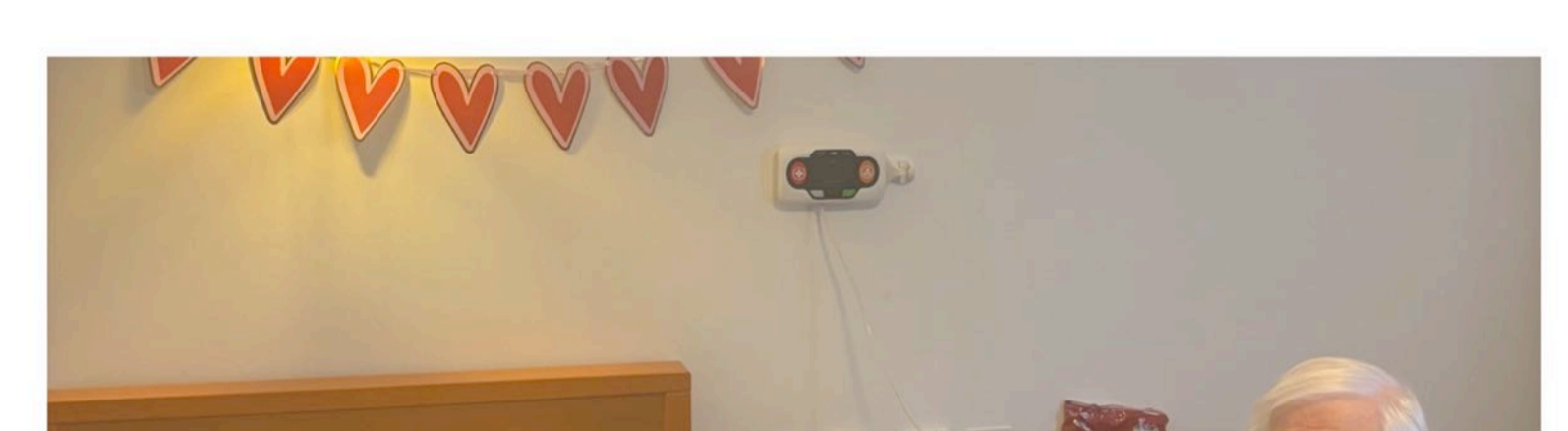


Staff News
