Change of Scenery

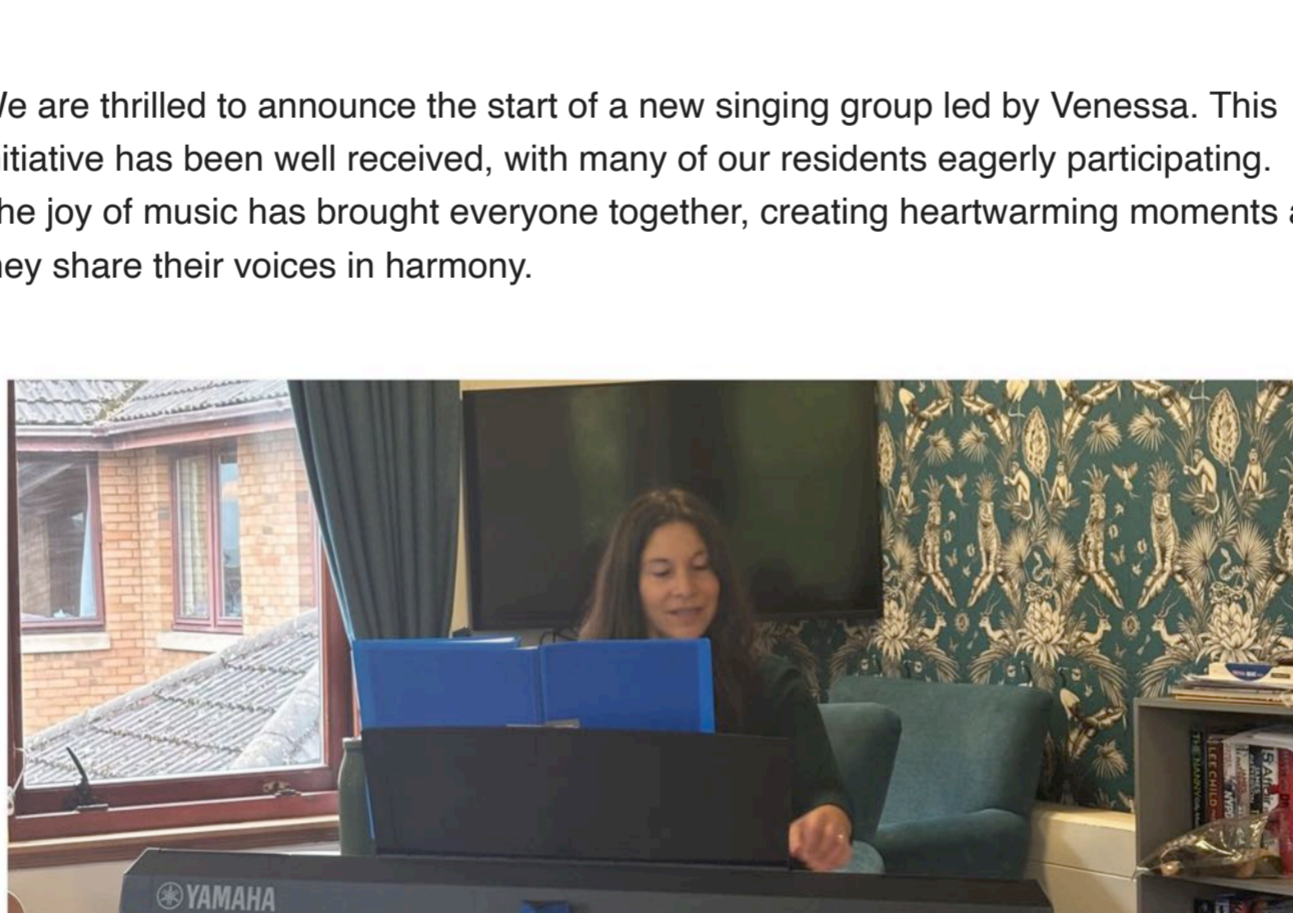

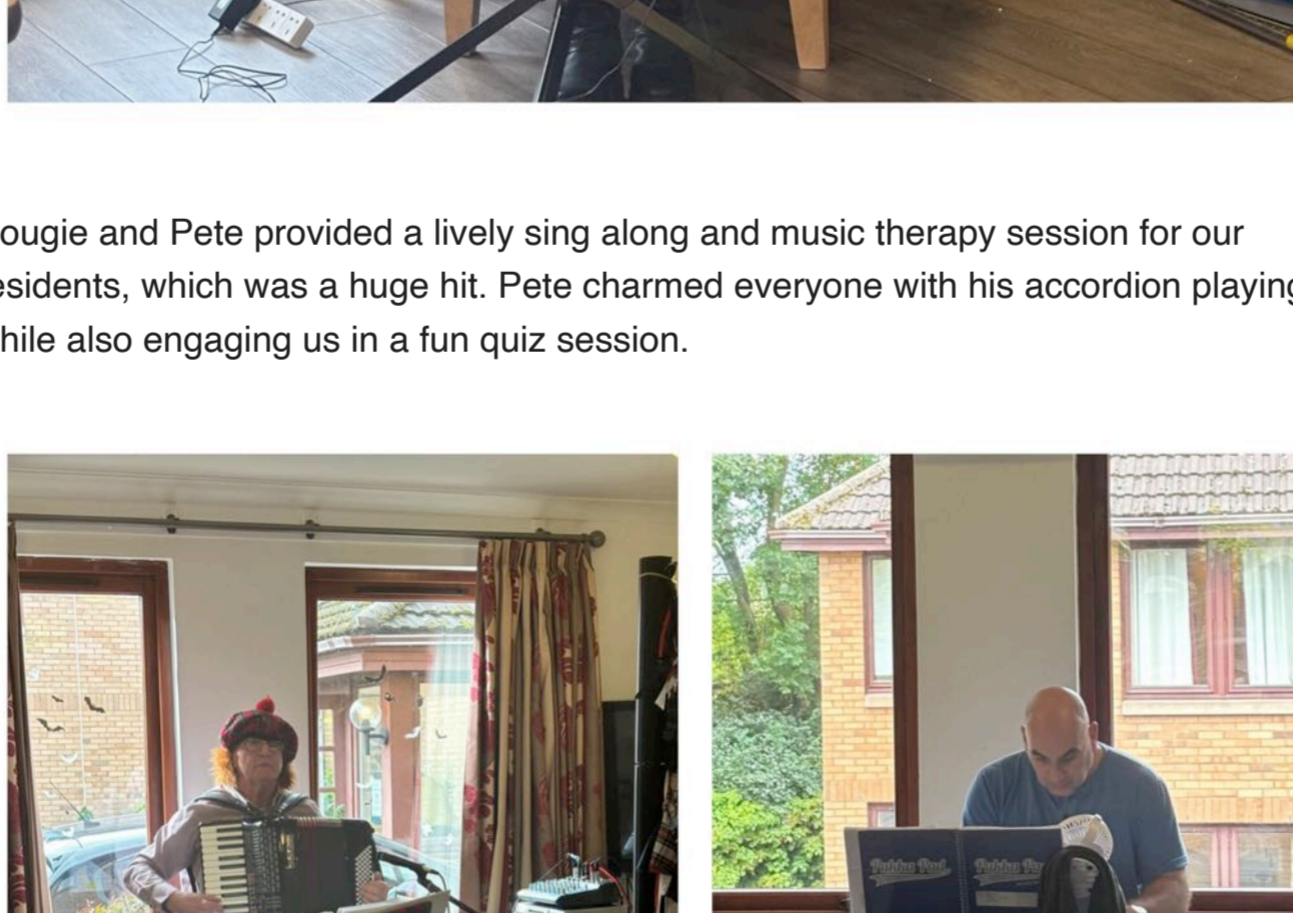
New Ventures in Music

Toes Tapping

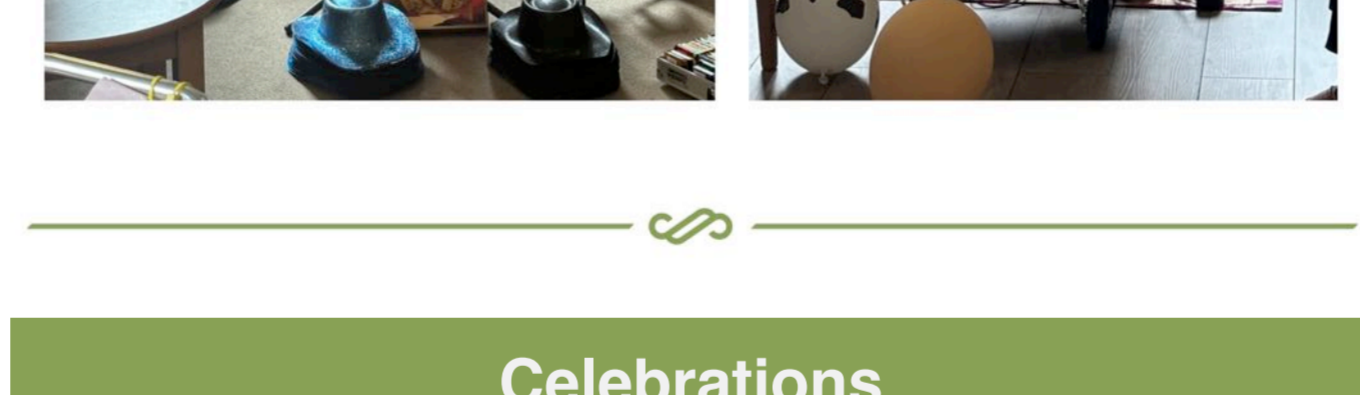

Birthday Wishes

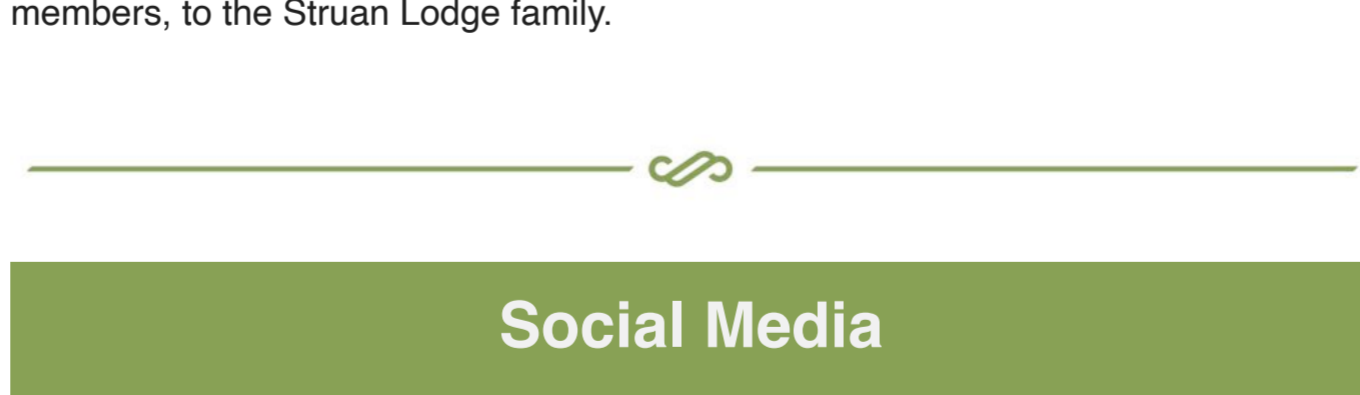

We're excited to welcome Danielle, Dionne, and Mireia, our new care team members, to the Struan Lodge family.

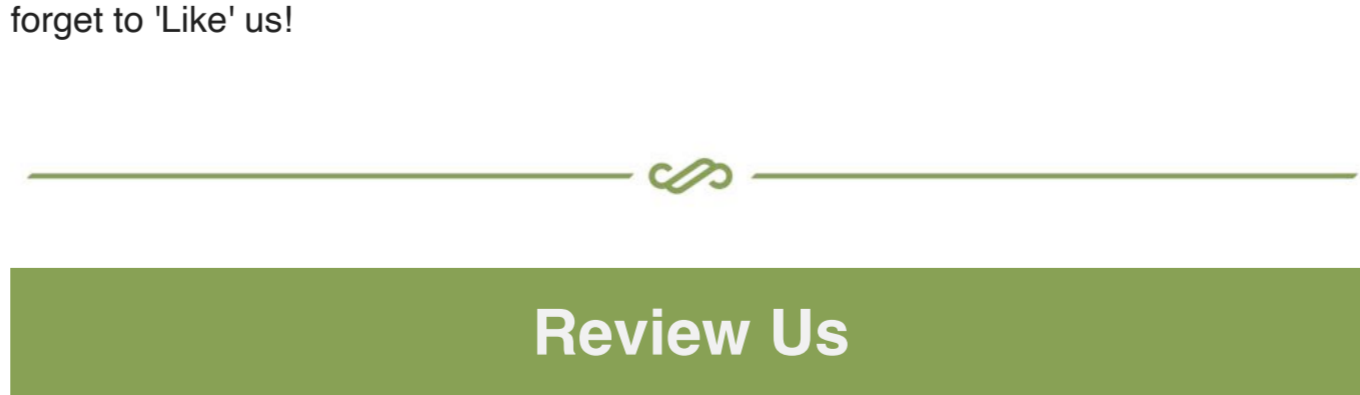
